# The Doctrine of Heaven and Hell

Synopsis:

#### Creation

## **Heaven:**

Genesis 2.1-3: Thus the heavens and the earth, and all the host of them, were finished. <sup>2</sup>And on the seventh day God ended His work which He had done, and He rested on the seventh day from all His work which He had done. <sup>3</sup>Then God blessed the seventh day and sanctified it, because in it He rested from all His work which God had created and made.

Matthew 25.34: Then the King will say to those on His right hand, 'Come, you blessed of My Father, inherit the kingdom **prepared for you from the foundation of the world**:

Revelation 13.8: All who dwell on the earth will worship him (the dragon), whose names have not been written in the Book of Life of **the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world**.

### Hell:

Matthew 25.41f: "Then He will also say to those on the left hand, 'Depart from Me, you cursed, into  $\underline{\text{the}}$   $\underline{\text{everlasting fire prepared for the devil and his angels}}$ . . . <sup>46</sup>And these will go away into everlasting punishment, but the righteous into eternal life."

Revelation 19.20: Then the beast was captured, and with him the false prophet who worked signs in his presence, by which he deceived those who received the mark of the beast and those who worshiped his image. **These two were cast alive into the lake of fire burning with brimstone**.

Revelation 20.10f: The devil, who deceived them, was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone where the beast and the false prophet are. And they will be tormented day and night forever and ever... <sup>14</sup>Then <u>Death</u> and <u>Hades were cast into the lake of fire.</u> This is the second death. <sup>15</sup>And anyone not found written in the Book of Life was cast into the lake of fire.
